Dear parents,

For the first time in over 2 years, we intend to hold a sports day event at our schools, with parents and family members in attendance. We have decided to run the event as a federation at Chapel Haddlesey School, allowing for children across the 3 schools to compete together. The theme of the day will be the Jubilee and we ask that the children come to school in red, white and blue coloured sportswear. All children should wear trainers rather than pumps please, as the ground is uneven.

Due to the high number of pupils, we have to split the event across 2 days:

Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> May KS2 (Year 3-6) 1.00pm-2.30pm Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> May KS1 (Nursery - Year 2) 1.00pm-2.30pm

The children will attend school in the morning, dressed in their sportswear and will have an early lunch. The pupils at Barlow and Burton Salmon will then travel on a coach from school to take part in the afternoon activities, and will then travel back on the coach to each school ready for a normal, end of day dismissal. We anticipate that it will be a warm day, so it's advised that your child arrives with a water bottle and adequate sun protection - long sleeves, hats and sun cream etc.

We warmly invite parents and family members to join us and ask that you come equipped for a restful afternoon - feel free to bring picnic baskets and refreshments (non-alcoholic of course!) and seating if required. The parking in and around Haddlesey is limited so please can we appeal to parents to walk, if local, and car share with other families if possible if driving from out of area.

If your nursery-aged child is not usually in on a Wednesday, they are more than welcome to join us for the event. Please can we ask that you transport them to Chapel Haddlesey; they can then join the nursery children for their events and can return to their family after they have taken part. Once Nursery children have completed their events, they are invited to play in the Early Years area with the other nursery children.

We look forward to welcoming you to Chapel Haddlesey Primary for a fun-filled afternoon.
