Federation Life Coach Afternoon for Year 5/6

Next week on Thursday 16th January, the Year 5/6 children across our federation will be taken to and from Burton Salmon School by coach to attend a Life Coaching Session. The session will be run by a qualified Life Coach and the children will be coached in aspects of friendships and hormones and how they affect mood. The session will cover how to deal with issues surrounding this, together with how to deal with conflict and resolution. We understand that children are dealing with a lot of transition in their minds and bodies during the final couple of years in primary school, along with the transition to High School, so having a Life Coach to discuss their hopes and fears for this transition period will be very beneficial to them.



Class 2 Selby College Coaching Sessions

Mrs Hall has arranged for our Class 2 and 3 children to attend Selby College for 2 PE sessions, to enable Selby College sports students to coach them.
